Dear Ms. McKinney,

This is in response to the question that arose regarding the recording of Carisbrooke Crossfire in the AKC Foundation Stock Service on October 31, 2007.

A dog is eligible to be recorded in the AKC Foundation Stock Service based upon its registration in a domestic or foreign registry that is considered acceptable by the American Kennel Club. The dog in question is registered with the American Jack Russell Terrier Association, an acceptable domestic registry.

The American Russell Terrier Club, the designated Parent Club for the Russell Terrier, inquired as to this dog's eligibility to be recorded in AKC FSS® in that the litter this dog is a member of, was not registered in Australia. In accordance with AKC FSS® eligibility and submission requirements, a recording application maybe accepted with export papers or with supporting documentation that identifies the breed of the dog, the sire and dam, and the ownership of the dog.

AKC staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the application and all supporting documentation submitted was in order, and that the recording of this dog in the AKC FSS® will stand.
